

Court bars Shippers Council from reversing storage charges ✓

A Federal High Court sitting in Ikoyi, Lagos, has barred the Nigerian Shippers' Council (NSC) from implementing an order reversing storage charges at the nation's seaports.

Ruling on an ex-parte motion brought before him by the Seaport Terminal Operators Association of Nigeria (STOAN), Justice Ibrahim Buba granted an injunction

restraining the NSC and/or its agents from implementing the reversal order pending determination of the substantive suit.

He adjourned the matter to Monday 10th November 2014 for further hearing.

It would be recalled that the NSC on Wednesday published an advertisement announcing the reversal of storage charges at the ports to that which was in force as at May 1, 2009.
