World Maritime University graduates largest class

ast Sunday, November 2, the Chancellor of the World Maritime University (WMU) and the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) Secretary General, Koji Sekimizu, conferred postgraduate degrees on the varsity's Class of 2014.

Compiling the largest class in the 31-year history of WMU, 124 students graduated from the Malmöbased M.Sc. programme in Maritime Affairs, 47 from the M.Sc. programme in Dalian, China, 36 from the M.Sc. programme in Shanghai, China, and 19 from the distance-learning Postgraduate Diploma in Marine Insurance. Overall, the graduates represented 49 countries.

Each year, students from roughly 50 countries live and study together at WMU to serve the global maritime community in the spirit of the United Nations.
