## Felixstowe Port receives full economic operator status

ne Port of Felixstowe, the Port of Britain, has become the first UK port to receive full Authorised Economic Operator (AEO) status.

The AEO initiative was introduced by the European Commission through the Union Customs Code to help simplify customs procedures and secure interna-

tional supply chains.



The AEO certificate is an internationally recognised quality mark issued by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs giving surety that the holder's role in the international supply chain is secure, and that their customs controls and procedures are efficient and compliant.
